

Australian Magician Honoured by Membership of The Magic Circle

Sydney magician, **Bruce Glen** has been made a member of *The Magic Circle* – the world's oldest, most prestigious magic club.

Bruce has just returned from London where he performed at The Magic Circle headquarters (known as *The House of 10,000 Secrets*). Last week, he was notified that he had been accepted as a member of this elite Society.

In recent years, Bruce Glen has become known for his unique presentation style which he has named: ***Bespoke Magic***.

For special events, he scripts and designs magic that is tailor-made for the occasion.

He is also recognised for his Close-Up magic which he performs at dinners, cocktail parties and trade shows before the very eyes of his audience – and often, in their own hands!

"I am delighted that my show at The Magic Circle was so well received. I prepared a special performance piece that touched on the rich history and tradition of the club. It was a great honour just to perform there – let alone to be considered for membership.

"To be accepted into a Society that includes some of the greatest names in magic is very exciting and encouraging. It will spur me on to further polish my skills and hopefully, to create more intriguing and entertaining magic," he said.

The Magic Circle was founded in London in 1905 and now has a membership of around 1500 spanning 38 countries. Its Latin motto, "*Indocilis Privata Loqui*", roughly translated means: "**NOT APT TO DISCLOSE SECRETS**" (indeed, any member who does so may be expelled from The Magic Circle).

The Magic Circle Headquarters and Clubrooms are housed at ***The Centre for the Magic Arts*** in London. The Society's museum contains priceless magical apparatus and memorabilia whilst the library boasts the largest collection of magic books in Europe. (See www.themagiccircle.co.uk).
